POSSESSIVE NOUNS



Definition

Possessive Nouns show ownership or possession.

Examples

- Cat's tail
- Aira's dress
- Ali's pen



Singular Possessive Nouns

These are the singular nouns that show possession or ownership.

Example:

The men's office is located on the third floor.

Plural Possessive Nouns

These indicate possession and are formed by adding apostrophe to the plural nouns ending with s.

Example: The children's clothes are new.

Possessive Pronouns

These are used in the place of nouns to show possession.

Example:

This dress is hers.

Irregular Possessive Nouns

Irregular Plural Possessive Noun forms from the Irregular Plural Noun. **Examples**:

My teeth's enamel is aching
