

RECIPROCAL PRONOUNS

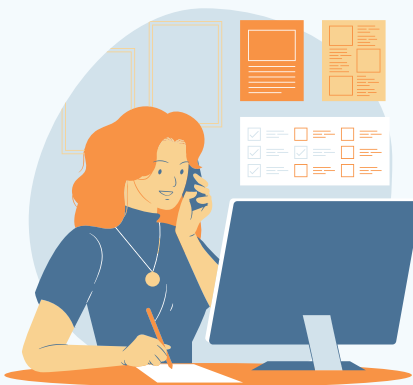


DEFINITION:

Reciprocal Pronouns represent the same relationship to each other among groups of people and are used to exhibit the same relationship among people. They indicate reciprocated interactions in sentence.

EXAMPLES:

- Ella and Evans respect each other.
- His siblings were blaming one another.
- They gave each other birthday gifts.

USAGE:

Use of Each other

- It is composed of two single pronouns.
- Represents a single reciprocal relationship.
- More prevalent.

Use of One another:

- Reached English Vocabulary in the 16th century.
- Used for acquainted individuals
