
RELATIVE PRONOUNS



A Relative pronoun is a type of pronoun used to introduce a relative clause in a sentence. It includes who, which, what, whom, or whose.

Relative Pronouns List:

Example Sentences:

- Anna, who is a doctor, also works as a lecturer.
- The bike **that** was lost last month was stolen.
- Ellen is the boy whom she was talking about.

Relative Pronoun	Usage	Example
Which	Used in non-restrictive clauseRefers to things	The home, which I bought yesterday, needs renovation
That	Used in restrictive clauseRefers to things	The last house that I owned wasn't ventilated.
Who	Used as subject PronounRefers to people	The girl who sits next to me is Aira.
Whom	Used as an object PronounRefers to People	I don't know the names of my classmates, whom I never interacted with.
