DYNAMIC VERBS

DEFINITION

Dynamic Verbs represent actions or processes done by people or objects. They are easily identifiable, don't show states, and possess a beginning and an ending.

EXAMPLES

- Eat
- Walk

Grow

• Talk

- Learn
- Go

TYPES

- I am walking, I'll call you later.
- She walked to the cafeteria.
- Kids are jumping up and down.
