- According to her mood, she will scold you for what you did.
- There is a hospital in front of my hostel.
- There is a library next to my hostel.
- She went to university instead of the extreme weather.
- The trip is supposed to be postponed because of the storm.
- Today will be off due to a public holiday.
- The flight will be delayed due to the storm.

PLACEMENT IN SENTENCE
